The programme is focused on a recent idea in the philosophy of science, namely that some form of organized scepticism is an essential scientific norm. The content of the programme will be a critical analysis of this idea and an elucidation of its historical development. The expected benefit for students is an advanced understanding of scientific method as integrating a norm of 'reasonable doubt'. A case study to be discussed in some detail is offered by some of the methodological elements of climate research where a distinction between 'reasonable doubts' and unreasonable ones is pertinent.
